WANTED: AUTO MUSEUM VOLUNTEERS

The Fountainhead Antique Auto Museum is seeking people to serve as educational ambassadors and help with a variety of museum activities. All applicants should have an interest in automotive and/or Alaska history and must be age 18 or older. Volunteers are needed for the following positions:

- **Museum Docents** lead tours, speak with visitors, and protect displays. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants should enjoy teaching and speaking in front of groups. Applicants are required to complete our free training course and are asked to commit to at least two 4.5-hour shifts/month during the summer and four hours/month in the winter.
- **Youth Educators** are docents trained to lead tours and activities for youth groups. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants should have some experience working with children. Youth educators are required to complete our free docent-training course and are asked to commit to leading 8 tours during the school year.
- **Pit Crew** members are docents trained to clean and detail cars and help set up or move exhibits. No prior automobile knowledge is required but applicants must complete our docent course.
- **General Volunteers** help with a variety of tasks which may include: setting up and cleaning clothing displays; database entry; car research; photography; event security; exhibit development; and organization of museum events.
